

Human Resources and Training Programs

1. Employment Ontario

A variety of programs for employers, employees, apprentices and job seekers administered by the Ministry of Advanced Education and Skills Development. Programs include:

Apprenticeship Training Tax Credit

A refundable tax credit for corporations and unincorporated businesses employing apprentices in certain skilled trades during the first 48 months of an apprenticeship program.

Job Bank

A Web-based network of job postings from all areas of Ontario and across Canada.

Ontario Job Creation Partnerships

An employment program that provides work experience to unemployed job seekers within projects that benefit the community or local economy.

Sector Initiatives Fund

Helps industry sectors and organizations develop training programs, standards and materials for their workforces.

Ontario Labour Market Partnerships

Supports partnerships among employers, employer/employee associations and community organizations. The program is intended to help partners develop and implement strategies to improve their ability to plan for their human-resource needs.

Summer Jobs Service

Provides free job search support and placement services to students. It also provides a \$2 per hour hiring incentive for employers who hire a student during the summer.
